On April 17th, SCAA President Angie Martin, and SCAA Executive Director Brian House participated in the American Petroleum Institute's – Spill Advisory Group (API-SAG) meeting, held at API headquarters in Washington, D.C. Also in attendance were SCAA-member company representatives John Swift (MSRC), Frank Paskewich (CGA) and Vania De Stefani and Paul Schuler (OSRL).

The API-SAG meeting brings together representatives from federal and state government, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), academia and the Oil Spill Removal Organization (OSRO) community on a semi-annual basis to share information and discuss ways to improve overall spill preparedness and response.

Notable agency updates included presentations from USCG, EPA, PHMSA and NOAA.
